

### **Patient Right's Charter**

### • Access to Care

Patients have the right to receive timely and appropriate care, including emergency care and access to healthcare facilities.

## Informed Consent

Patients have the right to understand the risks and benefits of their treatment options and to make informed decisions about their care.

## • Confidentiality

Patients have the right to privacy and confidentiality regarding their medical information.

## • Right to Refuse Treatment
